

Video Submission Guide - Androids

Some assessment tasks in moodle require you to submit a video as part of your assessment evidence. These video's are limited to a file size of a maximum 500MB.

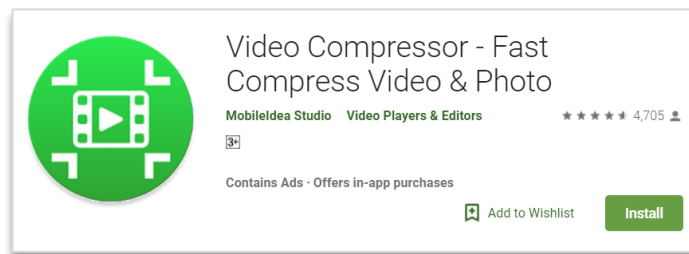
For video files that are larger than this, you will need to convert / compress the video to under 500MB, before uploading to Moodle. The below guide will show you how to do this.

Converting your video file

For recordings on an Android device, you can download the following free app from the google play store to convert the file.

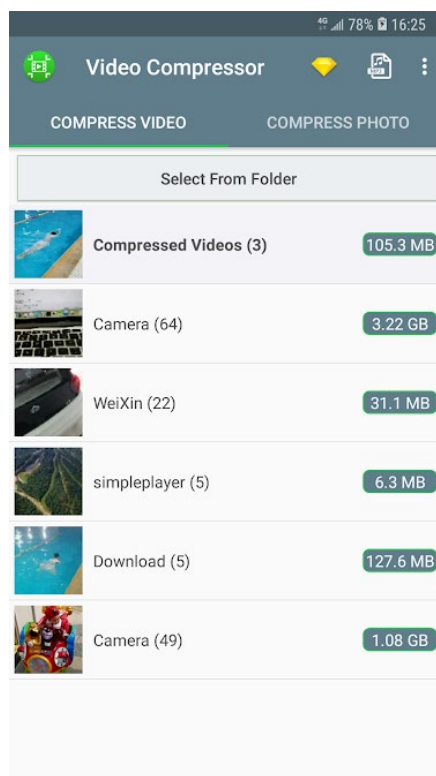

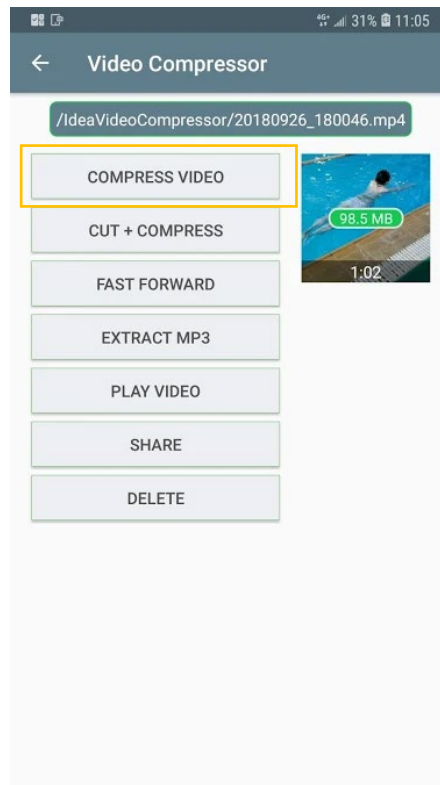


Step 1 – Open the app, and select ‘ALLOW’ to allow the app access to your photos, media and files on your device.

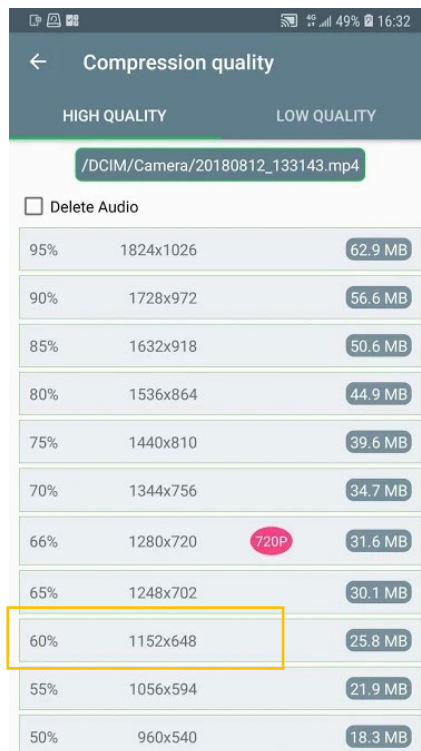
Step 2 – Locate the video file on your device, and select.



Step 3 – Click on ‘Compress Video’



Step 4 – The smaller the file, the quicker the upload into moodle (we suggest around 60% compression, or anything around 120MB for a 10 minute video)



Step 5 – For a 1GB Video, it will take around 5 minutes to convert. Once the video has been converted, it will save back to your gallery. Your video file is now ready to be uploaded to Moodle.
