

## Video Submission Guide

Some assessment tasks in moodle require you to submit a video as part of your assessment evidence. These video's are limited to a file size of a maximum 500MB.

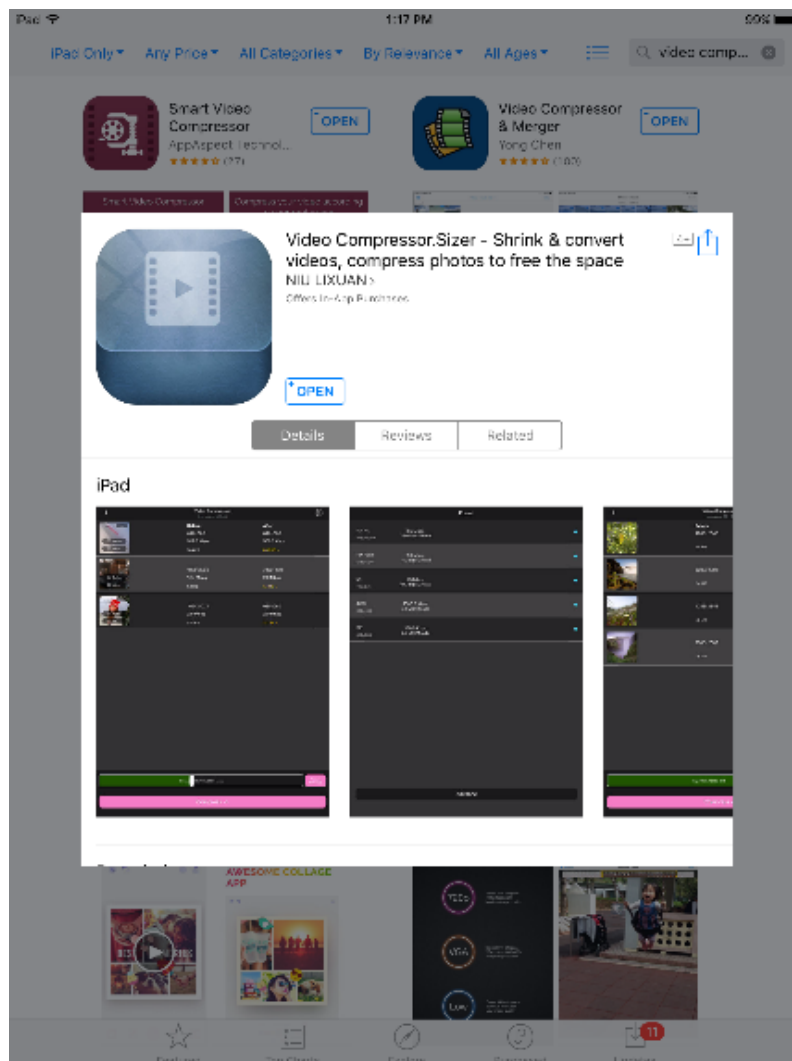
For video files larger than this, you will need to convert / compress the video to under 500MB, before uploading to Moodle. The below guide will show you how to do this.

### Converting your video file

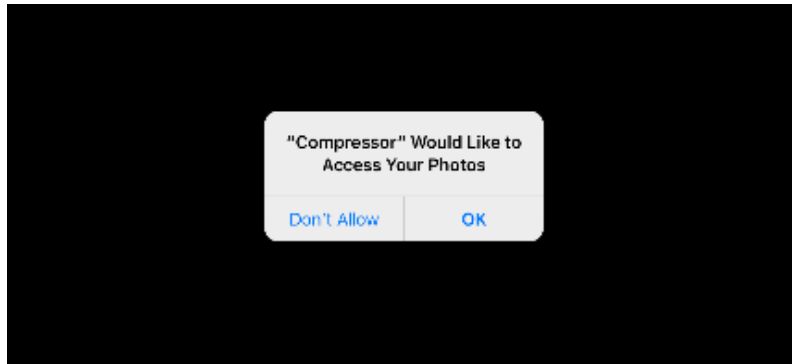
For recordings on an iPad or iPhone, download the following free app from the app store to convert the file.



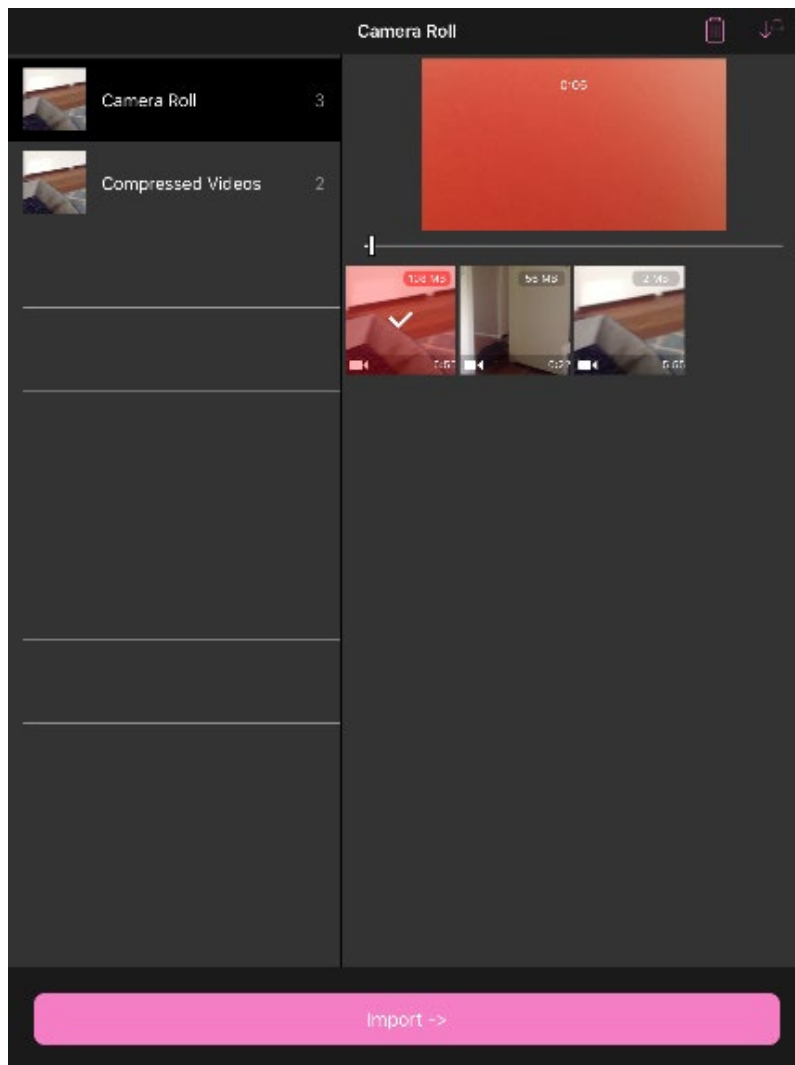

Step 1 – Open the app, and select 'OK' to allow the app access to your photos.

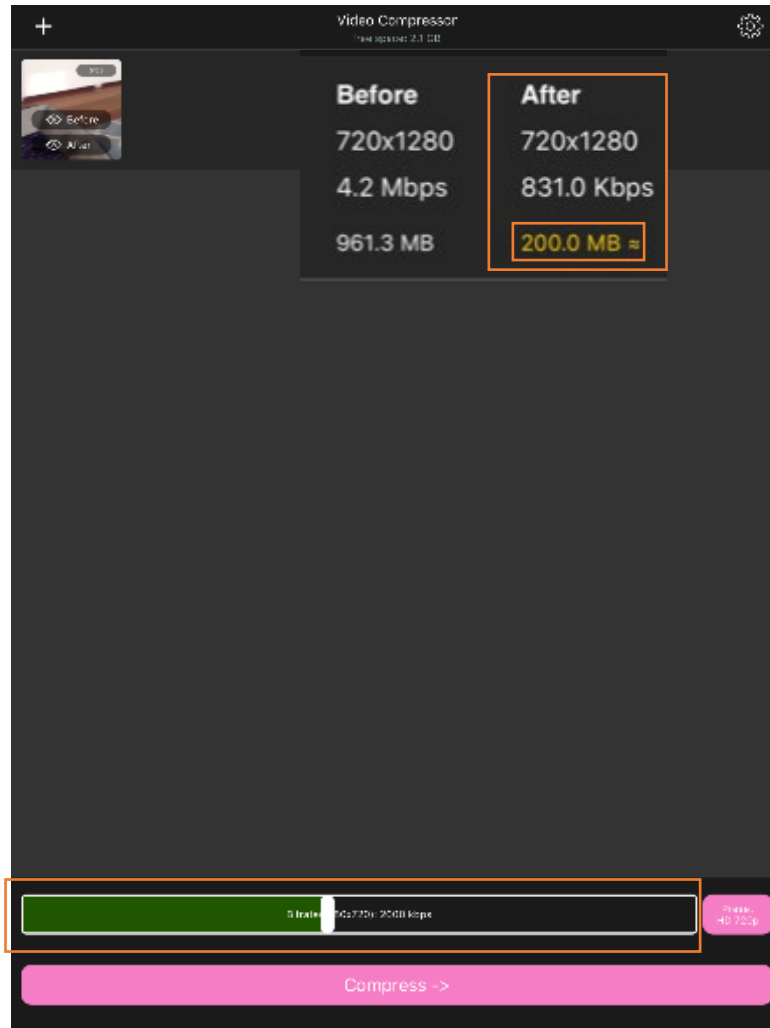


Step 2 – Locate the video file from your camera roll, and select 'Import'.



Step 3 – The compressor will show you the size of the file, *Before* and *After*.

- A. If this After size is under 500MB, you can click ‘Compress’ (or convert smaller again, see B)



- B. If the ‘After’ File size is over 500MB, move the green bar down the bottom to the left, until the ‘After’ is under 500MB (The smaller the file, the quicker it will upload to Moodle, so under 200MB is ideal)

*NB: Do not let your device lock while undergoing conversion, as you may be given an error.*

Step 3 – Once the video has been converted, it will save back to your camera roll. Here you can delete the uncompressed file.

Your video file is now ready to be uploaded to Moodle.
